DEPARTURE ROUTE DESCRIPTION

TAKEOFF RUNWAYS 1L/R: Climb on heading 007° to 540, then on heading 003° or as assigned by ATC, for vectors to SYKES, thence.
TAKEOFF RUNWAY 10: Climb on heading 097° to 540, then on heading 093° or as assigned by ATC, for vectors to SYKES, thence.
TAKEOFF RUNWAY 19L: Climb on heading 187° to 540, then on heading 213° or as assigned by ATC, for vectors to SYKES, thence.
TAKEOFF RUNWAY 19R: Climb on heading 187° to 540, then on heading 203° or as assigned by ATC, for vectors to SYKES, thence.
TAKEOFF RUNWAY 28: Climb on heading 277° to 540, then on heading 273° or as assigned by ATC, for vectors to SYKES, thence.

...on track 269° to DORMR, then on assigned transition. Maintain 6000, expect filed altitude within 10 minutes after departure.

TAKEOFF MINIMUMS

Rwys 1L/R, 10, 19R, 28: Standard.
Rwy 19L: Standard with minimum climb
of 220' per NM to 300.

Phylogenetic tree showing relationships between taxa. The tree is rooted at FROOT. The first split is at 28.5° (62) with a bootstrap value of *1300, leading to FL180 and a clade containing PSTOL, DORMR, and SYKES. FL180 has a bootstrap value of *1300. The PSTOL clade splits at 26.9° (48) with a bootstrap value of *1300, leading to PSTOL and a clade containing DORMR and SYKES. DORMR has a bootstrap value of 1600. The SYKES clade splits at 26.9° (12) with a bootstrap value of *1300, leading to SYKES and a clade containing CIGAR. CIGAR has a bootstrap value of *1300. The SYKES clade has a bootstrap value of 1300.
