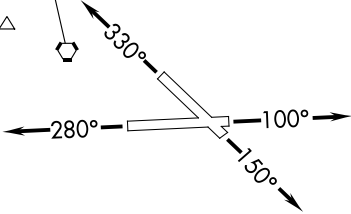

- TAKEOFF RUNWAY 15: Climb on heading 150°, thence . . .
- TAKEOFF RUNWAY 33: Climb on heading 330°, thence . . .

. . . for RADAR vectors to intercept filed/assigned route or enroute fix or navaid.
Maintain 4000, expect further clearance to requested altitude/flight level ten minutes after departure.
